Waste and different types of material to be recycled must be disposed of in one of two ways:


From Monday to Saturday (holidays excluded), between 6.30 and 8.30 am, rubbish bags can be taken to the boats moored in the following canals



### **HOW TO RECYCLE?** How to separate and dispose of recyclable materials and waste

## PAPER, CARDBOARD AND TETRAPAK

Monday, Wednesday, Friday



YES Newspapers, magazines, comics, notebooks, books, envelopes, photocopies, sheets of paper, flyers and brochures; Tetrapak cartons for drinks and food (juices, milk, wine); cardboard containers and strips; cardboard; cardboard boxes including for food; medicine boxes and instruction leaflets (without the medicine); cardboard egg boxes, light dirty pizza boxes.



GLASS, PLASTIC AND CANS

All material must be clean; otherwise it must go in the residual waste.

Plasticized, chemically treated or greased paper; too dirty pizza boxes or receipts.

DO NOT PLACE PAPER, CARDBOARD AND TETRAPAK IN PLASTIC BAGS

#### Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday

YES Bottles; bottles or tubes of liquid soap, cream, shampoo and bubble bath; empty plastic tubes; glass jars; food wrappers, containers and bags free of food residue; cellophane and transparent plastic wrapper for food; plastic containers and polystyrene for wrapping; plastic bags or nets; food cans and tins; tin foil and aluminum containers; plastic buckets, dishes and bowls; clean plastic cups and plates; clean jerry cans; clean pots of washable paint; bottle racks and crates.

All material must be free of food or content residue



Ceramics; drinking glasses; dirty or clean cutlery, dirty plastic cups or plates; rubber toys or objects.

all material to be recycled must be clean and without traces of food or liquid

### **RESIDUAL WASTE**

from Monday to Saturday

**TES** Kitchen waste, food left-overs; too dirty pizza boxes; used coffee and teabags; cut flowers and domestic plants; paper napkins; small domestic animal litter; either dirty or clean cutlery; rubber; soiled cloth; receipts and carbon paper, plasticized, chemically treated or greased paper; diapers and sanitary towels; cosmetics and toothpaste tubes; vacuum cleaner bags; small wooden and plastic objects; broken toys; light bulbs and ceramic fragments; porcelain and earthenware; marker pens, scissors and pens; audio and video taper, floppy disks, compact disks; dirty cups and kitchenware.

Cloth items; wrapping and packaging; large objects or rubble; paper, cardboard or Tetrapak; glass, plastic or cans.
