

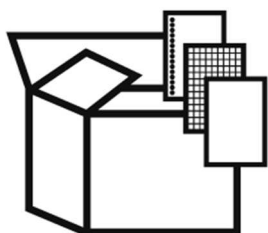
# Guide to sorted refuse collection

## On Murano and Burano:

- collection **bags**, one containing residual refuse, the other containing sorted items for the appropriate day, **must be placed outside the dwelling**, next to the front door, **between 06.00 and 08.00 hours**.

**Fines from 167 euros will be imposed on anyone dumping or failing to sort their refuse.**



## PAPER, CARDBOARD AND DRINKS CARTONS Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays

**yes** Newspapers, text and exercise books, envelopes, wrappers, photocopies, paper sheets, flyers and leaflets; paper bags; cartons (e.g. Tetra Pak) for beverages and food products (juices, milk, wine, purees and legumes); packets, cardboard boxes of all sizes; corrugated cardboard; lightly soiled pizza boxes.

**Important: paper heavily soiled with food or other matter must not be mixed with recyclable paper. IT IS FORBIDDEN TO PLACE PAPER AND CARDBOARD IN PLASTIC BAGS.**

**no** Plastic coated, chemical and wax paper; paper and cardboard heavily soiled with food and other substances.



## GLASS PLASTIC CANS AND METALS Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays

**yes** Bottles, jars, trays and containers made of glass, plastic, aluminium and metal; buckets and bowls; empty tubes; cans; cellophane, foil and transparent film; plastic bags of all sizes, including pouches, shoppers and mesh carriers; packs and wrappers used for biscuits, snacks and potato crisps; disposable plastic plates and cups free of residual matter; empty spray cans; lids, wire cages, corks and caps/stoppers.

**Important: materials must not contain residues of food or of the packaged product.**

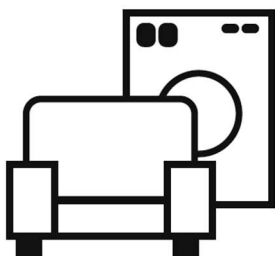
**no** Porcelain, ceramic and Pyrex, drinking glasses; crystal; mirrors, panes of glass, light bulbs and neon tubes; disposable plastic cutlery; toys and rubber items.



## RESIDUAL REFUSE Monday to Saturday

**yes** Kitchen waste and food leftovers; cut flowers and house plants; soiled paper napkins; small pet litter; rubber; soiled rags; plastic coated, chemical and wax paper; heavily soiled pizza boxes; plastic cutlery; nappies and sanitary towels; drinking glasses, crystal beakers (if broken, wrapped in newspaper), syringes and needles with cap; vacuum cleaner bags; small wooden objects; broken toys containing no electrical or electronic components; ceramic, porcelain and terracotta; felt tip markers, scissors and pens; audio and video cassettes, floppy disks, compact disks.

**no** Bulky and inert items; paper, cardboard and drinks cartons (e.g. Tetra Pak); glass, plastic and cans



## BULKY AND SPECIAL REFUSE

### Ecomobile household users only

*In front of the Rialto market, Monday to Saturday (except holidays), 08.00 -11.00 and 14.00 -17.00*

Collection of hazardous waste, batteries/accumulators, cans of paint, empty vegetable cooking oil containers, small electrical and electronic appliances, e.g. blenders, clocks, food processors, hair-dryers, computer components and accessories.

### Collection of bulky items from home by appointment

To dispose of refuse and bulky items exclusively of household origin, residents can use the home collection service, which is free for quantities up to one cubic metre. To make an appointment:

- > sms to 342.4112660 (indicating the customer code at the top left of the bill, the item/s that needs removing, and the address from which the collection is to be made);
